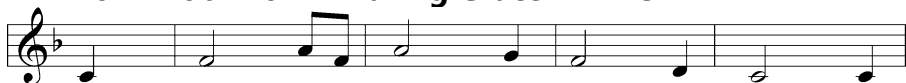
He served in the Air Force for 20 years and then was employed with Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department as a management analyst for 25 years.

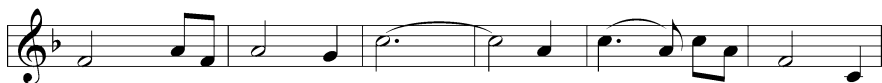
